Communications grant on agenda for supervisors

Inmate telephone services for the Calaveras County Jail, and a five-county effort to make broadband service available to remote areas, will be considered Tuesday by the Calaveras County Board of Supervisors.

Also, on Tuesday, the board will consider approving a new contract with the Service Employees International Union and adopting a number of resolutions making changes consistent with the new contract.

The inmate telephone issue before the board concerns dropping SBC Telephone Company in favor of a Delaware-based firm to provide telephone services for prisoners beginning March 1.

In addition to regular telephone services, inmate communications systems are required under the California Penal Code to contribute a portion of the fees for their services to the Inmate Welfare Fund. Evercom Systems, Inc. of Delaware offered to contribute 50 percent of the fees it collects, which is 4 percent more than the nearest competitive bidder was willing to pay.


The broadband telecommunications system under consideration for the benefit of remote areas of the county would be explored by the Amador-Tuolumne Community Action Agency in an effort to form a five-county region including Amador, Alpine, Calaveras, Tuolumne and Mariposa counties. The five counties then would pursue funding for various infrastructure, outreach and engagement projects funded by the California Emerging Technology Fund.

In its first year the project would identify ways in which it could connect existing public service "backbone networks" with community facilities, businesses and residences.

Ultimately, the plan is to lure larger telecommunications companies into expanding their services into what might otherwise be considered less desirable markets.

In other action, the board will consider:

- Raising fees collected by the Sheriff's office for its services in

implementing Earnings With Holding Orders from \$25 to \$30, and for its services in handling summonses and complaints from \$30 to \$35.

• What could be the last negotiating session for the purchase of 57 acres adjacent to the Government Center in San Andreas.
