### Digital Equity Checklist Planner Role - Best Practices


- 1. Convene Community Meetings about Broadband Needs.
- 2. Prepare Map of Unserved and Digitally Disadvantaged Areas and Identify Public Assets.
- 3. Share Map and Information with Regional and State Leadership.

#### **Broadband Mapping Resources**

- Review CPUC and FCC Broadband Map showing unserved areas and levels of service.
- Add CPUC Broadband Data and Map Shapefiles to your agency's GIS mapping.
- Review the California Middle Mile Network Map progress in your community.
- 4. Identify Strategies and Adopt Policies to Accelerate Broadband Deployment/Adoption.
  - Local Agency Utility Coordination Meetings Invite Internet Service Providers (ISPs) to join.
  - Micro-Trenching SB378 requires local agencies to allow micro trenching for broadband fiber installation. Adopt micro trenching policy and engineering standards.
  - Broadband Tower review streamlining Adopting guidelines and preferred standards.
- 5. Incorporate Maps, Strategies, and Policies into General Plan and CEQA Process:
  - General Plan Update to add "Broadband" and "Dig Once" terminology per State Guidelines.
  - Broadband Programmatic EIR to streamline CEQA Review.

EIR Example: Countywide Programmatic EIR for Nevada County Broadband Program.




