



## Broadband Project Permitting Process

Initiate a free consultation with the Planning Department, Public Works, and Building Department for discussion/feedback about the project scope of work.

The applicant applies for an [Encroachment Permit](#) from the Department of Public Works and/or a [Grading Permit](#) from the Building Department.

The application is reviewed for completeness and compliance with the [Program Environmental Impact Report](#).

If the project is within the scope of the [PEIR](#), the project is deemed exempt from further review under CEQA.

If the project is outside of the scope of the PEIR, A [Use Permit](#), and/or [Management Plan](#), and additional CEQA analysis may be required. See the Application Process [Guide](#).

Encroachment/Grading Permits are reviewed administratively, permits are issued, and project construction can begin.

Project review, CEQA document preparation, public hearing, and approval of Use Permit/Management Plan as shown in the guide linked above is needed prior to encroachment/grading permit issuance.
